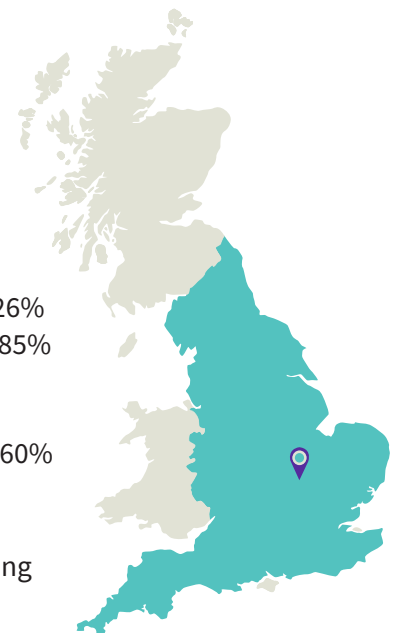

**KEY FACTS**

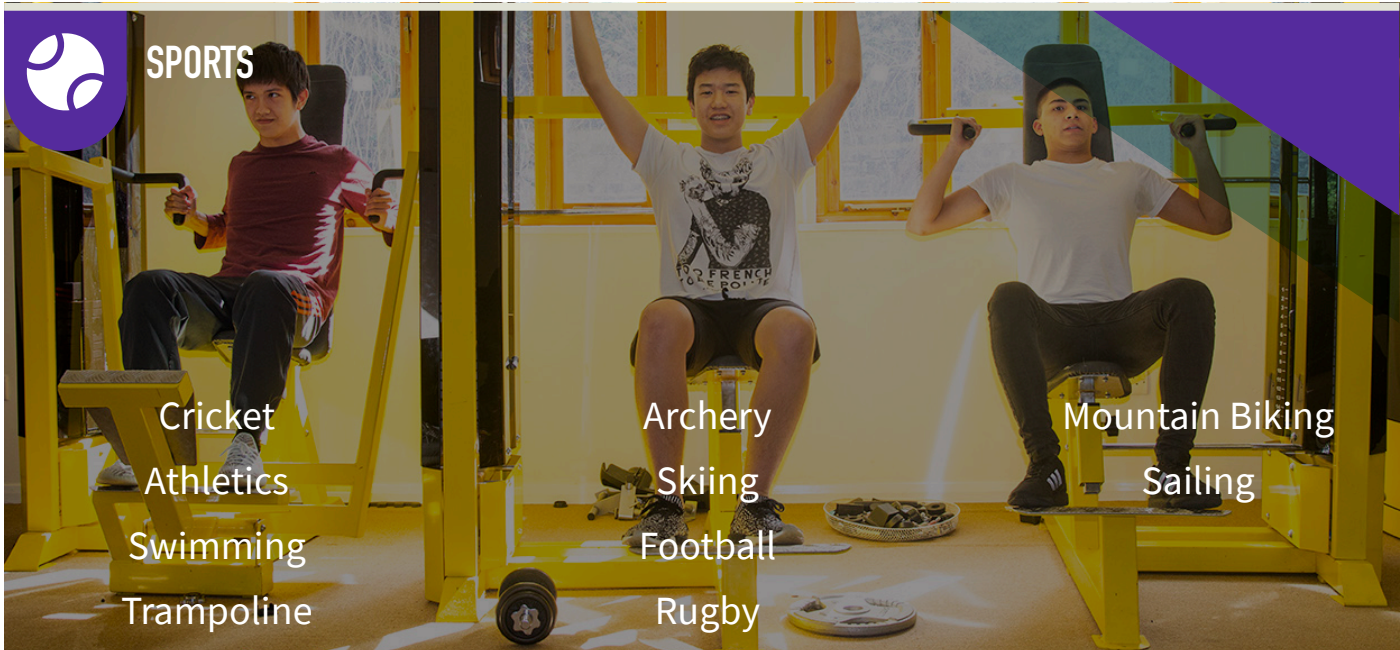
The teaching quality is excellent. It has been rated as a “key model school” by the UK Ministry of Education.
